Noted acute speech deficits and right sided neuro deficits of weak grasp that began just prior to arrival. Associated neck pain. He was walking in parking lot of Pomerado Hospital, being his grandson to the hospital for the flu, grandson (S) walked into a parked car and fell. (S) lifted repositioned in parking lot by nurse.
